

**FORTELA FW 20-21 PRESS RELEASE**  
**THE WINTER SEA**

The Fall Winter 20-21 Fortela collection pays tribute to the winter sea.

The mood finds inspiration in the Navy uniforms, with a palette of blues that refer to the dark and opaque shades of the sea.

The garments are carefully characterized by refined materials and tiny details, such as gold buttons and wooden frogs, which give recognition to the collection.

The shapes of the uniforms are updated in modern volumes, for a more contemporary elegance. The outerwear - unlined but warm -, as well as the knitwear and the trousers, and the materials that compose them - alpaca, cloth and heavy and thick wool - are designed to better face the very cold.

Durable denim is discoloured by the elements of life at open sea. These elements give a shaded and lived-in effect to jeans, which is worn in most casual moments, but always with a neat, elegant and refined touch.

When the rigor of the uniform and the discipline of military life give way to city clothing, the palette recalls the tones of wet sand, leaving some space for a more classic and free mood, but always suitable for each situation.

Main character here is the freedom to assemble small pieces, even coloured in knitwear, to create unique and recognizable outfit combinations, in line with the brand's philosophy.
