PIACENZA 1733 FALL/WINTER 2026-27 COLLECTION

Piacenza 1733 presents its **new Fall/Winter 2026-27 collection**, which revolves around the three distinctive pillars of the brand: **excellence in raw materials, unique colours and patterns, and innovation in knit structures.**

MATERIALS:

Piacenza 1733 has always upheld, generation after generation, a deep commitment to sourcing the world's **most noble and rare raw materials**, with full respect for the communities and regions of origin. This ongoing pursuit is built on direct, long-standing relationships with certified suppliers, ensuring traceability, sustainability, and uncompromising quality. For this season, the key blends are:

- **Extrafine Merino wool:** one of the world's most precious wools, chosen for its exceptional fineness. With a 19.5 micron count, it delivers remarkable softness, lightness and refined comfort.
- **Mohair and silk:** a luxurious blend of certified South African mohair and Mulberry silk from China. The mohair lends extraordinary lightness, softness and naturally airy volume, while the silk enriches the knit with a smooth, luminous touch.
- **Shambala cashmere:** the most precious fibre of Piacenza 1733, discovered by explorer Mario Piacenza in 1908 in the remote valleys of Tibet. Born in the extreme high-altitude environment of the Himalayas, it is distinguished by an exceptionally soft yet resilient underfleece, naturally light in colour and rich in depth. While remaining extraordinarily lightweight, Shambala offers a fuller, warmer handle and excellent breathability with superior thermal performance, retaining heat while ensuring comfort against the skin. Its naturally velvety sheen and elastic, voluminous fibres give the knit an enveloping and refined feel, expressing the purity, strength and mystical allure of the Himalayan "Roof of the World".
- **Supersense:** developed through a fully in-house, traceable process designed with the utmost precision. The selection of Supima cotton fibre, among the most precious and limited in the world, accounting for less than 1% of global production, is only the first step in an excellence-driven supply chain. For the first time, this extraordinary material is transformed into an exclusive yarn, engineered to achieve the perfect balance between lightness, handle and structure. From this yarn takes shape a jersey that goes beyond the material itself.

ICONIC KNIT STITCHES

- **Icon Fil a Fil Ikat Argyle Stitch:** creating a refined chromatic and graphic diamond pattern.
- **Icon Brushed Ikat Stripe:** producing delicate colour gradations and a soft visual effect. An iconic pattern and hallmark of Piacenza 1733, it represents the perfect synthesis of textile tradition and contemporary vision.
- **Diamond Cable Stitch:** highlighting texture and the yarn's natural movement.
- **Two Tone Slip Stitch:** adding depth and three-dimensionality to the knit.

COLOUR PALETTE:

Piacenza 1733 collections have always been distinguished by a broad, sophisticated palette deeply inspired by the tones of nature. Autumn/Winter 2026–27 unfolds around ethereal, powdery shades: warm, desaturated hues that recall winter landscapes and tranquil atmospheres, evoking a sense of escape and freedom. These nuances are complemented by more natural, reassuring colours, achieving a harmonious balance between delicacy and authenticity.

GREY: charcoal grey, mist grey

BLUE: ice blue, navy blue

GREEN: lichen green, tea green, forest green, turquoise green

YELLOW: winter dawn yellow

PINK/BROWN: cocoa brown, chocolate brown, cinnamon brown, dusty pink
